How to Request Air Ambulance

1. Call our Medical Control Number
562 746 9442
2. Have patient information ready: Diagnosis, medical equipment, O2 needs, x-rays and labs.
3. Give reason for transport and obtain signed consent form/DNR if pertinent.
4. Provide numbers of both facilities, sending and receiving for verification,
5. Provide Insurance Co. Authorization number and telephone contact
6. When the transfer is approved, the on call Flight Nurse will call for additional info and transfer orders.
7. One phone call will assist discharge planners in a stress-free coordination.
8. Inform if family member (1) will accompany.
9. The flight ACLS team will arrive at the hospital with aircraft stretcher for the bedside to bedside service.

We will contact ambulance companies and arrange for pickup of team,

transport patient to airport and airport pickup at destination



Aircraft and Equipment What you Need to Know:



- Are aircraft certified under Part 135 of the FAA?
- Is there FAA approved medical monitoring aboard?
- Is the Flight Team certified for medical flights?
- Does the company provide total coordination and bedside to bedside service?
- Is the company you called an approved AIR AMBULANCE or a Broker?
- Does the "broker" offer monetary incentives to doctors to fly you out? If so, YOU pay those fees.

By dealing directly with a Certified Air Ambulance operator, your costs will be greatly reduced and optimum care is provided without sacrificing quality.

Although the ICAO or the FAA do not regulate Aeromedical operations, they have standards we adhere to.
